

DCCT Hair Requirements 2018/19

The required hairstyle(s) for our 2018/19 season are as follows:

- High straight ponytail (hair slicked back)
- Low ponytail (middle part with slicked hair)
- Classical bun (hair slicked back)
- Low classical bun (middle part with slicked hair)

Each costume you receive at costume pick up day in February will come with a sheet that specifies which variation of our hairstyle is required for each that dance.

Expectations:

- dancers/parents are responsible and accountable for their own hair
- we ask that you have someone lined up to do your hair **prior** to arriving at the competition
(please do not rely on a teacher to do your hair)
- hairstyles must be done cleanly with no fly aways
- if you are required to have straight hair you must use a straightener
- students will be asked to redo their hair if it does not meet the standards

we understand competition gets busy and things come up so we just ask that you give yourself ample time and prepare to the best of your ability
